

## **Environmental & Sustainability Policy**

It is the policy Hendy Group to take action to minimise the environmental impact of its operations by:

- 1. Adopting repair and maintenance processes which are as environmentally sound as possible and comply with UK environmental standards.
- 2. Controlling any waste products produced by its work processes.
- 3. Seeking to reduce any environmental impact by controlled disposal of waste in accordance with UK legislation and its own environmental standards.
- 4. Wherever possible seek to recycle materials and waste products and continually look for ways to operate in a more environmentally and sustainable way.
- 5. Seeking to ensure that staffs are aware of the impact its operations have on the environment through ongoing training and information.
- 6. Providing information on environmental impact of its operations.
- 7. Appoint an environmental and sustainability officer to monitor and manage the impact of environmental issues on the business.
- 8. Waste is disposed off via registered carriers who transport the waste to registered sites. Records are maintained of the transfer of such waste.
- 9. Materials such as used oil, oil filters, scrap batteries, brake fluids, contaminated fuels, waste paint, metals etc are separated and sent for recycling or controlled disposal.
