

Hazardous Waste Policy

Hendy Group Aims

Hendy Group is committed to ensuring the health, safety and welfare of its employees and of others who may be affected by the waste materials, which result from our operation. The Group will arrange for the disposal of all hazardous waste products regularly and safely as it is committed to fulfilling its 'Duty of Care' to minimize Environmental impact.

Arrangements

Waste Disposal Containers

Suitable receptacles for the collection of hazardous waste will be provided in strategic positions throughout the workplace. Each container will clearly display the type of waste that it is designed to hold and waste products will only be placed into those receptacles that have been allocated for that purpose. Containers will be adequate to prevent the escape of waste and the containers will be emptied regularly and removed by an authorised person.

Disposal of Hazardous Waste

Suitable arrangements will be made for the disposal of hazardous waste that is generated as a by-product of our work. The correct pre-notification and documentation procedure will be followed for hazardous waste, and the Group has arranged for the removal of hazardous waste to be made in association with a licensed contractor.

Employees will be supplied with any personal protective equipment necessary for the safe handling of waste materials.

Information and Training

Suitable and sufficient information and training will be provided, as necessary, to ensure that employees fully understand these arrangements and that no person is put at risk by the inappropriate disposal of waste. The Managers have been provided with a tool box talk to assist with relevant training.

Records

Records will be kept of:

- Waste transfer and disposal arrangements (a transfer note will be completed and handed to the carrier or authorised waste disposal body - copies of a transfer note will be kept for a minimum of three years);
- Copies of Hazardous waste consignment notes, where appropriate, will be kept for at least three years; and
- Contractor's authority to carry out the work along with details of the waste that is transferred to particular companies.
